

## **Electric Lineman Apprentice/Journeyman**

The City of Wray, Colorado, is accepting applications for the Electric Department. The job is a full time position and includes but is not limited to working with high voltage electricity, operating bucket trucks and digger derricks, trencher, dump truck, loader and backhoe.

Successful applicant will have knowledge of electrical safety programs, have completed or be qualified to complete an apprentice program, strong interpersonal skills, and a valid driver license and able to obtain Class A Commercial Driver license. Prefer lineman experience with municipal systems. The City will require call out and on call rotation and the physical ability to work for extended periods in all types of weather conditions. Applicants must be willing to learn the operation and maintenance of the municipal distribution system (approx. 2 square miles) serving 2,300 residents. The City also requires the applicant to be willing to work in other departments as necessary. The successful applicant must pass a pre employment drug test.

Wages are dependent upon qualifications and prior experience. The City has an excellent benefit package with health insurance, PERA retirement, vacation, sick and personal leave and paid holidays.
