**Call to Order**

Mayor Joe Foltmer called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Minutes**

Council member John Willard made a motion to accept the March 11, 2014 Minutes as presented. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously. Council member K.T. Gregg and Jodi Brady abstained from the vote.

**Dean Wingfield - NECALG - County Express 2014 Donation**

Dean Wingfield, representing the Northeast Colorado Association of Local Government's County Express transportation program, provided trip and budget information. The Council was asked to consider approving an annual contribution. Council member Ronn Akey made a motion to approve the continued contribution of \$4250 to the County Express program. The motion was seconded and passed with five supporting votes. Council member K.T. Gregg opposed the motion and Council member John Willard abstained from the vote.

**Encore Life-Forgiveness Picnic Tables**

Encore Life Director Vonie Weaver presented an overview of the "When Pigs Fly" fund raising event to be held at the Wray Municipal Airport. The Council was asked for permission to use the city's PA Wagon and cones and to consider waiving the picnic table rental fee for the event. Council member Tyler Lightle made a motion to waive the table rental fee and provide bleachers and cones for Encore Life's fund raising event. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

**Wauneta Fire Department - Wray Daze Beer Gardens**

John Archer, representing the Wauneta Volunteer Fire Department, asked the Council for approval of the annual fund raising Beer Gardens to be held during Wray Daze. Council member Tyler Lightle made a motion to give permission to the Wauneta Fire Department to use the property in the shopping center and mud volleyball pits for the annual Beer Garden events. The motion was seconded and passed with six supporting votes. Council member K.T. Gregg opposed the motion.

**Manager's Report**

City Manager James DePue presented a written monthly Manager's Report. The Council expressed approval of the Wray Wrocks organization's project of replacing seats at the Wray Lions' Amphitheatre.

The Council was informed that no new information has been received regarding the Energy Impact Grant application for the wastewater facility improvements.

**Finance Report**

City Clerk Ida Peery presented information regarding the City of Wray's Cash Accounts.

**Approval of Bills**

Council member John Willard made a motion to approve the Accounts Payable Report in the amount of \$368,700.02. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

**Abandoned Houses**

The Council discussed creating an ordinance to address specific issues relating to abandoned houses. The issue will be placed on the May Council Meeting Agenda.

**Armstrong Consultants - Wray Airport Master Plan Scope of Work**

The Council reviewed the Wray Municipal Airport Master Plan Scope of Work Draft submitted by Armstrong Consultants.

**Pool Board Appointment**

The Council was informed that no applications have been received for the Pool Board Appointment.

**Wray Housing Board Appointment**

City Clerk Ida Peery explained that there are no term limits for the Wray Housing Board appointments. The Council was advised that Linda Schutte and B.J. Wilson have expressed interest in serving on the Wray Housing Authority Board. Council member Ronn Akey made a motion to appoint B.J. Wilson to the Wray Housing Authority Board. The motion was seconded and passed with four supporting votes. Council member K.T. Gregg opposed the motion and Council members Jodi Brady and John Willard abstained from the vote.

**Airport Fuel Card Bids**

No bids have been received. Issue tabled.

**Sanitation Truck Bids**

The Council reviewed the bids received for the lease purchase of a new sanitation truck. Faris submitted a bid in the amount of \$135,175, Peterbuilt submitted a bid in the amount of 205,000, and Kois Brothers submitted bids in the amounts of \$144,342 and 145,247. Council member Ronn Akey made a motion to approve the lease purchase with Kois Brothers in the amount of 145,247 which includes a trade in amount of \$32,000. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously. City Manager James DePue was given authority to proceed with the best funding option.


**Committee Reports**
